**Refund Policy:** Refund requests must be made in writing to IPOS Headquarters and are subject to a \$55 processing charge. A full refund of the Congress and Academy workshop registration fees will be made for the cancellations on or prior to 18 July 2007. A 75% refund will be made for cancellations from 19 July 2007 to 1 August 2007. A 50% refund will be given for cancellations from 2 August to 14 August 2007. No refunds will be made for requests received after 14 August 2007. No refunds will be made to individuals who attend a portion of the meeting.

**Substitution Policy:** If you are unable to attend the Psychosocial Academy or the 9th World Congress, you are welcome to send a colleague in your place. Each registration substitution will be subject to a \$55 processing charge. If your colleague is not a member of IPOS or BPOS and you are, your colleague must also pay the difference in fees between member and non-member rates.
